



Announcement of the Internal Audit Office, Maharakham University

Subject : No Gift Policy

Fiscal Year 2026

As Maharakham University has a policy of not accepting gifts (No Gift Policy) by requiring all government agencies to declare themselves as agencies where all government officials do not accept gifts and presents of any kind in the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy).

In this regard, to ensure that the operations of the Internal Audit Office maintain transparency and accountability, and to instill a professional value of integrity as a corporate culture in alignment with the guidelines for promoting morality and transparency free from corruption; The policy is hereby announced that executives and personnel under this Office shall not accept gifts or tokens of any kind from the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy). This applies before, during, or after the performance of duties that could lead to corruption or misconduct, and covers all festivals and special occasions. Exceptions are permitted only in necessary and unavoidable circumstances, in which case the acceptance of gifts, tokens, or any other benefits must strictly comply with the Prime Minister's Regulations on Giving or Receiving Gifts by Government Officials B.E. 2544 (2001), in conjunction with the Announcement of the National Anti-Corruption Commission on the Criteria for the Acceptance of Property or Other Benefits on Ethical Grounds by Public Officials B.E. 2563 (2020).

This announcement will accordingly be informed to all executives and staff in the office conscientiously following the policy
