



Announcement of the Internal Audit Office, Maharakham University
About the No Gift Policy
Fiscal year 2025

As Maharakham University has a policy of not accepting gifts (No Gift Policy) by requiring all government agencies to declare themselves as agencies where all government officials do not accept gifts and presents of any kind in the performance of their duties (No Gift Policy).

In this regard, in order for the Internal Audit Office to operate transparently and be auditable in accordance with the guidelines for promoting morality and transparency free from corruption, the policy is hereby announced for executives and personnel under the Office not to accept gifts and presents of any kind in the performance of duties (No Gift Policy) on all festivals and special occasions, except in cases where it is necessary and unavoidable, in which case the criteria for accepting gifts or presents and other benefits must be followed according to the Prime Minister's Regulations on Giving or Accepting Gifts by Government Officials B.E. 2544, together with the announcement of the National Anti-Corruption Commission on The 2020 Code of Conduct for Government Officials on Accepting Property or Other Benefits Ethically.
